Friendly & Important Reminders:

Corresponding with your camper -A reminder that campers are *not* allowed to make or receive phone calls except on Birthdays. We encourage correspondence through letter writing. Parents can email messages to the campers, and the messages will be handed out at mail call. There is *no* camper access to computers. If your son has had a physical examination within the last year, then an updated Health Form is all that is required for our records this season.
